And he only paused a moment when he heard him holler, "Stop!"

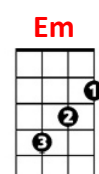
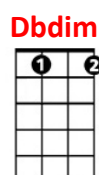
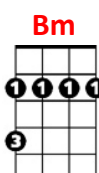
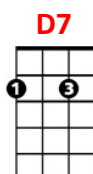
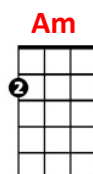
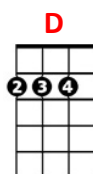
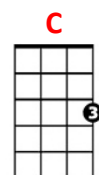
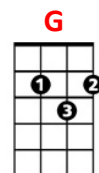
**G** **C** **G**
